GREEN E.Th.I.Cs: Art as an Engine for Change

Green E.Th.I.Cs is an European project funded by the 2021 Creative Europe Program and it is developed by an interdisciplinary partnership made of **18 partners** and 64 associated partners in **12 European countries**. Among the partners, there are theater companies, universities and research centers, cultural hubs, social organizations, and public institutions.

Green E.Th.I.Cs aims to raise climate change awareness and enhance the transition to more sustainable attitudes and ways of living by engaging citizens as key players in interactive cultural and artistic actions.

Furthermore, organizations and partners participating in the project are committed to embracing changes for a more sustainable production of cultural events, activities, and festivals through the development, adaptation, and implementation of a **Green protocol** for the reduction of carbon emissions in the artistic sector.

All protocols, technical prototypes, and tools are adopted by the partners not only during the project but also after its conclusion.

»»» Green E.Th.I.Cs Live Game



All artistic groups will follow a methodology determined by the University of Turin, which leads the project. Among the other innovations, this methodology includes that, while in traditional theater actors and audience stand separately, in **Green E.Th.I.Cs Live Game** the stage is the territory and community is the main character of the action. In this process professionals are involved to guarantee a high quality of the actions implemented.

Audiences are actively engaged in critically reflecting on climate change via **LIVE performances** of the Green E.Th.I.Cs Game (GEG). The game is an interactive, multidisciplinary format, based on the Game of Goose.

GEG combines verified scientific data, critical thinking, and emotional engagement of participants. Audiences participate in the creation of content and organization of the GEG, and they actively perform, next to professional actresses/actors, in high-quality artistic productions becoming protagonists of the Cultural Green Engagement action itself.

GEG is also developing into a BOARD and ONLINE version, thus becoming easily disseminated and accessible to a new audience that normally does not benefit from cultural events.



»»» Teatro a Pedali (Pedal-powered Theatre)

Teatro a Pedali (Pedal-powered Theatre) is a prototype aiming to promote self-sustainability and raise awareness on Eco sustainability and green energy. It is an electric co-generation system composed of a series of bicycles connected to a storage system. During the LIVE shows, the participants are asked to cycle to produce the energy needed for the show, turning the performance to a sustainable low environmental impact event.



Other actions in the next months will be shows (performances, festive events, representation, installations, participative gaming actions) that allow to **involve the community**, stimulate participation, and generate a sense of wonder in local communities. The type of intervention is defined on the base of the goal of the intervention and the needs and characteristics of the territory.

The final goal is the formulation of two Green Protocols:

- a) a **Green protocol on sustainable project management** that will promote an environmentally friendly way to progress the project's objectives while paying attention to mitigating possible negative environmental, social, and economic impacts on its implementation and
- b) a **Green Protocol on organizing and conducting sustainable cultural events** by considering the negative impacts on the environment and minimize to the lowest possible level all negative impacts

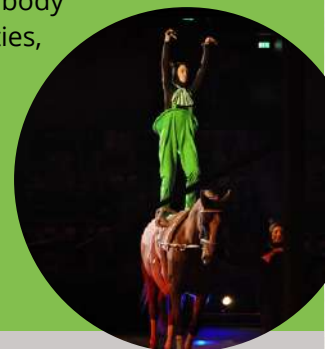


CAPRIFOLEN

Evaluation

The Évora University was the second university to be established in Portugal in November 1 of 1559. Famous Iberian professors gave their classes there, among them Pedro da Fonseca, the most important Portuguese philosopher from the 16th century. Over the last years, the University has fostered a close link with the community. Such interaction has been possible through the creation of working networks, the participation in the Science and Technology Park as well as through the establishment of protocols and co-promotion research projects.



FIRST MEETING OF GREEN ETHICS

>>> OUR JOURNEY IS BEGINNING

The journey of **Green E.Th.I.Cs** began almost a year ago. It was in **November 2022** in Ayllón, a small medieval Spanish town. Here, among streets and squares that tell ancient stories, the journey of the European project Green Ethics began.

Residui Teatro was the promoting organization, in collaboration with the **Spanish Ornithological Society (SEO)** and **IES Rafael Alberti**.

In this initial meeting, the foundations were laid for 18 entities from 12 different countries to establish a collaboration with the goal of **raising awareness among European societies** about environmental issues through fun and engaging activities with active audience participation.

GREEN ETHICS IN TURIN

>>> 3 DAYS FOCUSED ON PARTICIPATION AND SUSTAINABILITY

Commitment, collaboration and cooperation: these are the keywords that best describe the three days spent in Turin by all the partners of the European project **Green E.Th.I.Cs**.

The 18 partners led by **SCT Centre/Unito** gathered in **April 2023** to analyze the project and the steps that will bring them to the realization of **110 live performances** in public squares, 1,200 theatrical activities, and 50 workshops in ten European cities, involving around **45,000 citizens** in a large Green Cultural Engagement project by 2026.

In the following days, partners were able to learn about and interact with the two cultural artistic formats that are part of the Green Ethics project: the interactive **Goose Game** created by **SCT Centre** together with **Polo del '900** and the **Cycling Powered Theatre** by **Mulino ad Arte** association.

Subsequently, they began to ideate some contents of the **Green E.Th.I.Cs** performances, starting from the scientific contents resulting from the research of the **Polytechnic of Crete TUC**.

This creative work continued in Crete, in October 2023, when artistic partners met to work and finalize the Green E.Th.I.Cs performances that will be presented in all the partner countries in 2024.



STUDIO 7

Artistic Partner

In 1992, director Christoph Falke founded **STUDIO 7** as an ensemble theater to develop and explore acting techniques and an own theatrical language, which the group conveys through performances and educational work.

Since 2010, **STUDIO 7 Theater** has been active with a young generation of actors and has realized projects on the local, regional, and international level. Since 2015, the ensemble runs the cultural centre/cultural pub "Auf der Heide," where they produce a range of artistic and cultural offerings.

GREEN ETHICS IN CRETE

➤➤➤ A CREATIVE BREAK FOR GREEN ETHICS

The 11 artistic partners of Green Ethics traveled from their respective countries to gather in Crete, where they were welcomed by the host group, Omma Studio. On this beautiful Greek island, they engaged in a creative exchange for 5 days with the aim of collaboratively developing the Green Ethics Game, an interactive theater performance on environmental themes.



The show is set to take the stage in the second half of the coming year. SCT Centre, the leading artistic group of the project, coordinated the game co-creation sessions. Environmental message content and audience interaction dynamics were considered, and each group will perform according to its unique characteristics.

These were a few intense and highly enriching days of ideas and proposals for all.
